1. Call to Order:
Scott Yunker at 6:36pm
2. May 3rd Minutes Approval – approved a seconded
3. Treasurer Report: including deposits from Crushers registrations, expense to Cascade SD for new fields and concessions expenses, balance as of 5-18-09 \$13,256.
4. Concessions Report:
Suzanne Wolfe & Kristy Hartsell
Revenue at this time is \$6,932 and expenses at \$8,294 – net of <\$1,362> Budgeted \$10,000 for expenditures. This is due to a large number of hotdogs and sausage dogs purchased for last tourney that are still not sold (over 550). Pretzels are the largest seller at this point and will be snow cones to come as the warmer weather arrives.

Crushers selling hamburger meals and have one side open for just snow cones. 7th and 8th grade were going to assist with a handful of girls no by Wednesday, Ann will talk with habitat for humanity and will know on Tuesday. Jesse Olivara’s team, has eleven children maybe able maybe 4 kids could come out. 8 per shift and 3 hours per shift, for 6 inside and 2 outside. Call Dennis Deno for flipping burgers.
5. All-Star Discussion
 - a. All Star fees and were they go, mis conception from last meeting, the \$40.00 will be for the team, pendants, etc. - not to offset the all-star league costs (uniforms, hats, insurance, D7 fees, etc.). Proposal to not have a fee and then each team mom/manager has to collect individually from players to cover team costs. Motion, seconded and approved.
 - b. Gear Purchase (Hat styles for each division) – Jr’s use the same uniforms and would like to have a budget for hats and get \$10.00 per player. Krista will take care of this will cover to order 18 hats. Total \$180.00, motion, seconded and approved. Numbers are just not available for a 10-11 team. 9-10 and 11-12 proposal for Jason to order \$180.00 (each team) for hats. Move to make a \$180.00 for each all-star team. Girls do visors, sunglasses. May have a 10-11 Girls team. Motion, seconded an approved.
 - c. Need six hats for the C for tomorrow’s game with Devin. Call Lovell to get matching hats if some left. We will reimburse for what is necessary for Girls.
 - d. Change Try Outs and date to June 15th – changed from the 13th. Remain the evening of the 15th at 6:00pm.
 - e. Different highlight colors on the scorebooks for 9-10 and 11-12
 - f. We need boundary maps from Debbie and D7 signatures. If maps overlap then over verify that go to the eastern city limits of Jefferson. Scott and Debbie get together soon
 - g. Yolanda will be coming the 17th and 18th to certify and certification with Debbie is the 25th of June.
