



# Cascade Little League Procedures

Title: All Star Team Procedures	Effective Date: January 1, 2009
---------------------------------	---------------------------------

## Purpose

To set standard procedures in the selection of manager, coaches and players for Little League All-Star tournament team play.

## All-Star Teams

1. Players selected for Cascade All-Star teams, and their parents must sign a commitment contract in order for the player to become an official team member.
2. Manager and coaches for Cascade All-Star team are required to sign a commitment contract to become an official team member.
3. Replacements may be sought for individuals who choose not to sign or fulfill their contract.
4. The League shall provide each Cascade All-Star team member with a Little League All-Star pin.
5. Only Cascade All-Stars may have the option to purchase League All-Star jackets.
6. Each player on a Cascade All-Star team shall pay a fee for the cost of their uniform. Players who are unable to pay the full amount at one time may set up a payment arrangement established by the League President.
7. The Cascade Little League Board members eligible to vote shall determine All-Star team roster.
8. The Cascade Little League population will determine the fielding of All-Star teams. The Cascade Little League Board members may elect to not field each All-Star Division.

## Minor All-Stars (9 & 10 Year Olds)

1. Players must be evaluated at a tryout to be eligible.
2. Major and AAA managers and coaches at the All-Star try-out shall select ten players by vote. Ten players receiving the greatest number of votes shall automatically receive a spot on the All-Star team. The manager shall then select the remaining players (up to 4) from the next top eighteen to fill the roster.
3. The board of directors shall select a team manager from a list of persons who have submitted a letter of interest in the position to the League President. The Board's review shall include but not be limited to the manager and coaches on-field conduct; interaction with league officials, parents and players; and contribution to the league at large.
4. The approved managers shall select their coaches, who must then be approved by the Executive Committee.
5. The coaching staff of the All-Star team may consist of one (1) manager and up to two (2) coaches. The manager and coaches selected must be officially rostered.

## Minor All-Stars (10 & 11 year olds)

1. Players must be evaluated at a tryout to be eligible.
2. Major and AAA managers and coaches at the All-Star try-out shall select ten players by vote. Managers/coaches shall not vote for any player their team's regular season roster. Ten players receiving the greatest number of votes shall automatically receive a spot on the All-Star team. The

manager shall then select the remaining players (up to 4) from the next top eighteen to fill the roster.

3. The board of directors shall select a team manager for from a list of persons who have submitted a letter of interest in the position to the League President. The Board's review shall include but not be limited to the manager and coaches on-filed conduct; interaction with league officials, parents and players; and contribution to the league at large.
4. The approved mangers shall select their coaches, who must then be approved by the Executive Committee.
5. The coaching staff of the All-Star team may consist of one (1) manager and up too two (2) coaches. The manager and coaches selected must be officially rostered.

#### Major (11 & 12 year olds) through Senior division All-Stars

1. The appropriate division managers and coaches, as specified below, will submit player nominations for the own division. At a meeting called by respective Division Coordinator or the League President, player nominations shall be presented. By division, each manager, and on coach per team, will vote for a given number of players. That number shall be two less than their division's All-Star roster size.
2. The player agent shall prepare a list for each division of all eligible players for the respective divisions All-Stare team. By division, each player who is eligible for his/her division's All-Star team shall ten vote for a given number of players form their division. That number shall be two less than their division's All-Star team roster size.
3. The player agent along with the division coordinator and league president shall tally the points from the players' and manager/coaches vote for each player, and the appropriate point system shall be applied to the top group of vote recipients. The top ten point recipients for Majors, Junior & Seniors shall be on their division's All-Star roster. If a tie should occur at the #10 slot, all mangers will vote on those players for selection for the #10 slot or the team manger agrees to pick up the tied players realizing this may impact the team manager and coaches selections(s) in item #5.
4. The team manager and coaches shall select the balance of the roster from among the next eight top vote recipients.
5. The manager of the regular season team possessing the best Cascade only league record in their division shall be given first option to manage their division's All-Star team. Should they decline, the position shall be offered tot the second place team manager, then the third, and so forth.
6. The board of directors shall confirm the All-Star manager by majority vote. The Board shall not unreasonably withhold its approval. The Board's review shall include but not be limited to the manager and coaches on-filed conduct; interaction with league officials; parents and players; and contributions to the league at large.
7. Managers of the divisions shall select their coaches, who must then be approved by the Executive Committee. The coaching staff of the All-Star team may consist of one (1) manager and one (1) coach if 12 rostered players and one (1) manager with two (2) coaches if 13 rostered players. The manager and coaches selected must be officially rostered.

#### Major All-Stars (11 & 12 year olds)

1. The Major division managers and coaches shall vote for the Major all-Star team.
2. Major division players who are league age 11 and 12 shall vote for the Major All-Star team.
3. The Player Agent along with the Division Coordinator and League President shall take the top ten vote recipients from the player's vote and apply a point system of one to ten points, with the top

vote recipient receiving ten points, nine for the next, etc. Likewise, a point system of eleven to twenty points shall be applied to the results of the manager/coach vote, with the top vote recipient receiving twenty points, nineteen for the next, etc. The points resulting from each vote shall then be combined.

4. The ten players receiving the greatest number of points shall be on the Major All-Star team. The manager will select the remainder of the roster from the next top eight recipients.

#### Junior All-Stars (13 & 14 year olds)

1. The Junior division managers and coaches shall vote for the Junior All-Star team.
2. Junior division players shall vote for the Junior All-Star team.
3. The Player agent along with the Division Coordinator and League President shall take the top ten vote recipients for the player's vote and apply a point system of one to ten points, with the top vote recipient receiving ten points, nine for the next, etc. Likewise, a point system of eleven to twenty points shall be applied to the results of the manager/coach vote, with the top vote recipient receiving twenty points, nineteen for the next, etc. The points resulting from each vote shall then be combined.
4. The ten players receiving the greatest number of points shall be on the Junior all-Star team. The manager will select the remainder of the roster from the next top eight recipients.

#### Senior All-Stars (15 & 16 year olds)

1. The Senior League managers and coaches shall vote for the Senior All-Star team.
2. Players 14 years old who played in the senior Softball division are eligible to play on the Senior Softball division all-Star team.
3. Senior division players shall vote for the Senior All-Star team.
4. The Player Agent along with the Division Coordinator and League President shall take the top ten vote recipients from the player's vote and apply a point system of one to ten points, with the top vote recipient receiving ten points, nine for the next, etc. Likewise, a point system of eleven to twenty points shall be applied to the results of the manager/coach vote, the top vote recipient receiving twenty points, nineteen for the next, etc. The points resulting from each vote shall then be combined.
5. The ten players receiving the greatest number of points shall be on the Senior All-Star team. The manager will select the remainder of the roster with the next top eight vote recipients.

#### Big League All-Stars

Big League All-Stars shall be under the authority of the district Administrator.

## *All Star Commitment Form*

Now is the time for Cascade Little League All-Star selection. All eligible players, selected by your regular season coach, will be asked to fill out this form. Not all players will receive this form, only those chosen by your coach. Please read this form completely and review the commitment requirements necessary to play at the All-Star tournaments.

All-Stars is available to players that are a minimum league age of 9, as of April 30<sup>th</sup>, and have played in at least 60% of all regularly scheduled games. The commitment necessary to play is governed by All-Star coaches but should be understood players could be asked to practice every day until the tournament begins. Since we will only have approximately two weeks from the end of the season until the first game, making every practice is extremely important. Missing practice or games because of a vacation or other function may result in not being selected for the team.

To be considered for All-Stars, you must complete that following additional requirements. If these items are not attached with your nomination slip, your name will not be submitted for All-Star consideration and you will be ineligible for try outs. Please include the following items:

- Three acceptable forms of proof of residency
- Copy of the players certified birth certificate, the original must be available upon request.

There is a \$30.00 fee required for All-Star participation for baseball. CLL supplies the jersey uniform, hat entrance fee and insurance for the tournament. All other costs are the responsibility of the player. This year we are offering a variety of All-Star items to order, we are hoping that every player and their families will find something to commemorate the 2009 tournament season. Remember these items are optional; please do not feel obligated to make any additional purchase.

Tryouts will be held for all 9,10, and 11 year olds on \_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_ To be selected to the team, you must participate in the tryout. All 11 and 12 year olds will be selected by a draft of all players presented by their regular season coach. Players will be notified no sooner than \_\_ Only selected players will be notified, players not selected will not be notified. Please do not call the coaches for a listing for players. Team selections will be posted on Lindy's and at [www.cascadell.com](http://www.cascadell.com) on \_\_\_\_\_ .

Please understand that filing out this form does not guarantee selection to an All-Star team, it only shows that coaches which players are available and willing to commit to play. By

signing this form, players and parents understand that they are making a commitment to play on the team that they are selected for. Failure to sign this form will make the player ineligible to play on any All-Star team at any level. No form will be accepted without both player and parent's signature.
