



Cascade Little League Procedures

Title: Cougar Scholar Program

Effective Date: January 1, 2010

Purpose

To provide Cascade Little League the guidelines needed to recognize a Cougar Scholar.

The Cougar Scholar Program is Cascade Little League's way to recognize our top student athletes for their outstanding efforts in academics.

Procedure

1. The Cascade Little League Board will recognize T-Ball through Juniors scholars with a 70 percent and/or 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA).
2. The Cascade Little League Board will use a scoring system that matches the GPA system in our education system.
3. The Cascade Little League team managers may select a team parent to help facilitate the Cougar Scholar process.
4. A designated Cascade Little League Cougar Scholar Representative will identify a token of achievement from the Cascade Little League that will be awarded to each qualifying Cougar Scholar.

Rules

1. To be eligible for the Cougar Scholar, the player must submit a copy of their second trimester report card to their designated team parent no later than May 15th of each season. If no report card is submitted by the schedule date, the player is ineligible.
2. Scholastic Eligibility Form shall be filled out by designated team parent with an attached copy of report card to the designated Cascade Little League Scholarship Coordinator by May 20th of each season.
3. The designated Cascade Little League Scholarship Coordinator will verify eligibility and report results to the Cascade Little League Board.

Scoring System

*Subjects to score are:

Language Arts
Reading
Science

Spelling
Math
Social Studies

*Scores:

A/+	=	4	B/√	=	3
C/-	=	2	D	=	1

Add up scores and divide by the number of subjects scoring to get the GPA.
