



# Cascade Little League Procedures

## Purpose

To provide Cascade Little League the guidelines needed for player registration and league participation.

Cascade Little League is a non-profit organization administered solely by volunteers. Board members, managers, coaches, scorekeepers, umpires, concession people, plus many others, are all volunteers and sacrifice enormous amounts of spare time to insure the success of Cascade Little League.

## Procedure

1. Cascade Little League Board members will establish a minimum of 3 player registration dates.
2. Cascade Little League encourages all returning and new ball players to register/sign-up as early as possible to insure for a uniform and a well-planned ball program.

## Rules

1. Player registration fees are set by the league board members prior to the season's first player registration date. A late fee of \$10.00 will be assessed if a player signs up after registration.
2. There will be No Refunds given after the first try-out date.
3. To be eligible for tournament play, at time of player registration, all players must show original and certified, State issued Birth Certificate. A hospital birth certificate will not be accepted.
4. A "Certified Abstract of Birth" from California will not be accepted as proof of age. Original Birth Certificate may be requested from:
  - a. State Vital Statistic Birth Certificate
  - b. U.S. Government Passport
  - c. U.S. Government Form F5240
  - d. DD Form 1173 (Military ID Certificate)
  - e. N585 Form (Naturalization Form)
5. All players who participate in the Major division and lower will take part in league fundraiser. Parents may opt to "buy out" their child's fundraising obligation.
6. All teams are required to provide a concession stand crew on assigned dates. A minimum of four people are required for each shift. No person under the age of fourteen is allowed to work in the concession stand during regular season. Parents may opt-out of the concessions obligation by paying the designated opt out fee.
7. Each team shall designate a Team Parent who will be the contact person for fundraisers and concession stand obligation.
